# NOTIFICATION – CHANGE OF ENGINE

Marine Safety (Domestic Commercial Vessel) National Law Act 2012, Schedule 1

Marine Order 503 (Certificates of survey – national law)

Marine Safety (Class C restricted C operations) Exemption

This form can be used to notify AMSA of a change of an engine(s) on a domestic commercial vessel.

If the vessel holds a non-survey approval (under Exemption 2), please notify AMSA of the change of engine by lodging an application to vary a vessel certificate or approval (AMSA 566) instead of this form.

Please note that changing a vessels engine may require the vessel to meet additional standards, undergo surveys and/or be required to obtain a certificate of survey. This notification may need to be supported by a recommendation from an accredited marine surveyor that confirms that the engine change does not invalidate the assumptions and calculations used for the structural or stability design approval for the vessel.

- **does not** invalidate the assumptions and calculations used for the structural or stability design approval for the vessel; and
  - **has not** altered the arrangement of any of the other systems on the vessel (e.g. electrical, fuel, shaft, structure, footprint etc.).
- I have attached supporting documentation for the engine that confirms the above details and includes the engines serial number.
