Kelly announces new AMSA CEO appointment

Parliamentary Secretary to the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Transport and Regional Services, De-Anne Kelly, today announced the appointment of the new Chief Executive Officer of the Australian Maritime Safety Authority, Mr Graham Peachey.

Mrs Kelly said Mr Peachey was formerly the Chief Executive Officer of Food Standards Australia New Zealand, a statutory authority in the Health and Ageing portfolio.

“Mr Peachey has considerable experience in public sector executive management, particularly in regulatory agencies, and a strong record of achievement both domestically and internationally,” Mrs Kelly said.
