Missing aircraft wreckage found

The wreckage of a Cessna 206 aircraft that was reported overdue on a flight from Bankstown airport in Sydney to Archerfield in Brisbane has been found about 55 kilometres north east of Scone.

The wreckage was identified by a Careflight Helicopter that subsequently landed and confirmed the identity of the missing aircraft. New South Wales Police are now in the area and as such coordination of the operation will now be handed to them.
