APPLICATION FOR PROVISIONAL REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE

Shipping Registration Act 1981
Section 22, Regulation 15

This application should be accompanied by:

1. The instrument (if any) by which ownership of the ship passed to the owner named in the application;
2. If the application is signed by the master of the ship, documentary evidence of appointment and of authority to sign the application;
3. The tonnage certificate (if any) that is in force in relation to the ship;
4. If the ship has at any time been registered under the law of a foreign country, documentary evidence that:
 - (a) the ship is no longer registered under the law of that country; or
 - (b) steps have been taken, or are proposed to be taken, to close the registration of the ship under the law of that country on or before the grant of the provisional registration certificate.

Proposed Ship's Name

Names that may not be approved are:

- names that are the same as or similar to names of registered ships or of ships about to be registered,
- blasphemous or otherwise offensive names,
- names of members of the Royal family,
- names that falsely suggest a connection with the Royal family, or international, national, state or local government bodies,
- names that include prefixes capable of indicating a type of ship (e.g. MV, FV, SS).
