NOTES

1. Tonnages:

Gross and net/register tonnages are measurements of volume. Other types of tonnage such as deadweight or displacement are not applicable.

2. Charterer:

The particulars of the charterer are required only if the applicant is a charterer.

3. Proposed commencing and concluding dates:

The temporary pass will be valid only during the time span of these dates. Care should be taken to make a realistic estimate of the duration of the voyage.

4. Signature:

Where the person signing is a corporation, the declaration may be formally executed under seal. Alternatively an officer of the corporation may sign the form and endorse it with a legible statement of his/her name and designation and have the signature witnessed.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS TO BE LODGED (as applicable)

- Authority for an agent to sign the application
- Permission by the owner for the charterer to take the ship on the voyage
- Authority for a person to sign the application on behalf of charterers.
- Tonnage certificate (if any).
- Copy of the document of which you acquired the vessel.

The information requested in this form is required by the Shipping Registration Act 1981. It will be used for the purposes of the Act and will be available for search. It may be made available to government agencies for statistical and administrative purposes.
