Navigation Act 1912
Application for a Declaration
Under Section 8AA
(Trading Ships)

Section 8AA of the Navigation Act 1912 (the Act) allows the owner of a trading ship to apply to the Authority for a declaration that the Act applies to the ship even when the ship is proceeding on a voyage other than an overseas or interstate voyage.

There are penalty provisions for failing to comply with the Act.

Note: The cost of a declaration under section 8AA is \$215.
