**Marine Safety (Lifejacket lights) Exemption 2018**

**1 Name of instrument**

This instrument is *Marine Safety (Lifejacket lights) Exemption 2018*.

**2 Duration**

This instrument:

- (a) commences 1 July 2018; and
- (b) ceases to have effect at the end of 30 June 2020.

**3 Definition**

In this instrument:

***Marine Safety (Domestic Commercial Vessel) National Law*** — see Schedule 1 to the *Marine Safety (Domestic Commercial Vessel) National Law Act 2012*.

**4 Exemption**

- (1) A domestic commercial vessel that is a Class 1C vessel is exempt from the requirement in Table 2 of NSCV Subsection C7A for a lifejacket to have a light that complies with Annex A of the Section.
  - (2) However, subsection (1) does not apply to each lifejacket provided for the master and crew of the vessel.
