NOTE: To be eligible for issue of an Australian Maritime Mobile Service Identity (MMSI) number you must have obtained one of the proficiency certificates listed below.

- First-Class Radio Electronic Certificate (1st Class REC);
- Second-Class Radio Electronic Certificate (2nd Class REC);
- GMDSS General Operator's Certificate of Proficiency (GOCP);
- Restricted Radio Operator's Certificate of Proficiency (RROCP);
- Marine Radio Operator's Certificate of Proficiency (MROCP);
- and
- Marine Radio Operator's VHF Certificate of Proficiency (MROVCP).

NOTES ON COMPLETING THIS FORM

- If the radio equipment is for a **maritime vessel**
 - Complete section A, B and G
- If the radio equipment is for a **SAR aircraft**
 - Complete section A, C and G
- If the radio equipment is for a **land based station**
 - Complete section A, D and G
- If the radio equipment is for an **AIS land based station**
 - Complete section A, E and G
- If the radio equipment is for an **Aid to Navigation (AtoN)**
 - Complete section A, F and G
