Marine Safety (Lifejacket lights) Exemption 2015

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is Marine Safety (Lifejacket lights) Exemption 2015.

2 Duration

This instrument:

- (a) commences when it is made; and
- (b) ceases to have effect at the end of 30 June 2018.

3 Definition

In this instrument:

Marine Safety (Domestic Commercial Vessel) National Law — see Schedule 1 to the *Marine Safety (Domestic Commercial Vessel) National Law Act 2012.*

4 Exemption

- (1) A domestic commercial vessel that is a Class 1C vessel is exempt from the requirement in Table 2 of NSCV Subsection C7A for a lifejacket to have a light that complies with Annex A of the Section.
- (2) However, subsection (1) does not apply to each lifejacket provided for the master and crew of the vessel.
