Pursuant to 5.2 of Marine Orders, Part 12 (Construction — Subdivision and stability, machinery and electrical installations), I, the undersigned Alex Schultz-Altmann, accept the use of:

International Association of Classification Societies (IACS) Recommendation Rec.024:  
Intact Stability Rev. May 2004 and  
Bureau Veritas (BV) Rules for Ships Pt D, Ch 14, Sec 2.2**

As being equivalent to the prescribed use of the National Standards for Commercial Vessels requirements in Part C – Design and Construction, Section 6, Subsection 6A Intact Stability Requirements, Clause 6.6 Vessels Engaged in Towing in respect of those vessels engaged in towing operations to which the *Navigation Act 1912* applies.

This certificate is only applicable to Australian flagged ships to which Marine Orders Part 12 (Issue 3) until the **1<sup>st</sup> of January 2013**, the next amendment or re-issue of Marine Orders Part 12, or if amended by the Australian Maritime Safety Authority which ever is sooner.
