



**EXEMPTION – section 334 of the *Navigation Act 2012***

**Exemption from the manner of giving notice under subsection 16(4) of *Marine Order 41 (Carriage of dangerous goods) 2017***

I, Gregory Pusey, Manager Vessel Standards, in accordance with section 334 of the Navigation Act 2012:

**exempt** a shipper from compliance with the requirement to give notice in the manner prescribed in subsection 16(4) of *Marine Order 41 (Carriage of dangerous goods) 2017* to the extent that the notice must include a Multimodal Dangerous Goods Form or a dangerous goods transport document completed in accordance with Chapter 5.4 of the IMDG Code

**for** the shipment of an excepted package of radioactive material of class 7

**subject to** the condition that the notice must include:

- (a) documentation for the goods in accordance with provision 5.1.5.4.2 of the IMDG Code; and
- (b) a copy of this exemption certificate.

*Note* Provision 5.1.5.4.2 of the IMDG Code provides:

- 5.1.5.4.2 *The documentation requirements of 5.4.1 and 5.4.5 do not apply to excepted packages of radioactive material of class 7, except that:*
- .1 *the UN number preceded by the letters "UN" and the name and address of the consignor and the consignee and, if relevant, the identification mark for each competent authority certificate of approval (see 5.4.1.5.7.1.7.) shall be shown on a special transport document such as a bill of lading, air waybill or other similar document complying with the requirements of 5.4.1.2.1 to 5.4.1.2.4; and*
  - .2 *the requirements of 5.4.1.6.2 and, if relevant, those of 5.4.1.5.7.1.7, 5.4.1.5.7.3 and 5.4.1.5.7.4 shall apply.*

This exemption commences when made and remains in effect until the end of **1 August 2025**.
