# **SECTION 11**

# **Fire Appliances**

Vessels must comply with the <u>National Standard for Commercial Vessels</u> (NSCV) Part C Design and <u>Construction, Section 4 Fire Safety Equipment.</u>

With the following notes added to Clause 1.1 Scope, of the referenced NSCV Part C Section 4:

### NOTES:

- 1. NSCV Part C Section 4 includes the requirements to cover both:
  - Section 5, Construction, Sub-Section F, Structural Fire Protection, and
  - Section 11, Fire Appliances.
- 2. Only those parts of the NSCV Part C Section 4 covering fire appliances (active fire protection measures) are applicable to this Section of the USL Code.

With the following specific provisions to apply:

### PART 2 – SCALES OF FIRE FIGHTING EQUIPMENT

The requirements for fire-fighting equipment are replaced by the requirements contained in <u>NSCV Part C Section 4</u> (which replaces Section 11 of the USL Code).
