Section 5F: Construction – Structural Fire Protection (SA)

SUB-SECTION F

Structural Fire Protection

Vessels must comply with the requirements contained in the *National Standard for Commercial Vessels* (NSCV) Part C, Design and Construction, Section 4, Fire Safety relating to passive fire protection measures.

With the following notes added to Clause 1.1, Scope, of the referenced NSCV Part C Section 4:

NOTES:

- 1. NSCV Part C Section 4 includes the requirements to cover both
 - Section 5, Construction, Sub-Section F, Structural Fire Protection, and
 - Section 11, Fire Appliances.
- 2. Only those parts of NSCV Part C Section 4 covering structural fire protection (passive fire protection measures) are applicable to this Section of the USL Code.
- 3. Those parts of Part C Section 4 covering fire appliances (active fire protection measures) are not applicable in South Australia.
