Marine Safety (School vessels) Exemption 2013

I, Graham Peachey, Chief Executive Officer of the Australian Maritime Safety Authority (the National Marine Safety Regulator under section 9 of the *Marine Safety* (*Domestic Commercial Vessel*) National Law) (the *national law*), make this instrument under subsection 143(1) of the national law.

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is Marine Safety (School vessels) Exemption 2013.

2 Duration

This instrument:

- (a) commences on 1 July 2013; and
- (b) ceases to have effect at the end of 30 June 2018.

3 Exemption

- (1) This section applies to a domestic commercial vessel that is:
 - (a) owned by:
 - (i) an agency of the government of a State or Territory; or
 - (ii) a primary or secondary school; and
 - (b) used only by a primary or secondary school for curricular or extracurricular activities for students of a primary or secondary school.
- (2) The vessel is exempt from the application of this Law.

Note this law is defined in section 6 of the national law to include the regulations and any other legislative instrument made under the national law.
