6 Payment

Photo requirements

The photo of you must meet the same requirements as a passport photo.

You can have these taken at any store offering passport photos.

If you choose to take the photo yourself, this is what we require:

- · A good quality colour print, on glossy photo page, with no ink or marks on the image.
- · No retouching of any kind (including removal of background, moles, wrinkles or scars).
- · Clear, focused image with no marks or 'red eye'.
- · Plain white or light grey background that contrasts with your face.
- Uniform lighting (no shadows or reflections), with appropriate brightness and contrast to show natural skin tone.
- Face centered and looking at the camera straight on; not tilted in any direction.
- · Hair off your face, so that the edges of your face are visible.
- · Eyes open, mouth closed.
- · Neutral expression (not smiling, laughing or frowning).
- Photos have to be 35mm to 40mm wide and 45mm to 50mm high.
- The size of the face from chin to crown can be up to a maximum of 36mm, with a minimum of 32mm (see diagram).



Some examples of demonstrated professional association membership include:

- · AIMS stamp showing membership level and expiry date
- · RINA letter confirming class of membership and expiry date
- · IIMS membership card
- IMarEST membership card.

Please note, a tax Invoice alone is not acceptable, you must obtain a written statement from the association.

Continuing professional development

Professional development can be with a professional association related to vessel survey, design, engineering, or vessel building.

Evidence must include either a statement of continued professional development (CPD) from your professional association, or copies of certificates relating to any of the following:

- · additional qualifications you may have attained
- short courses/safety training
- · technical meetings/conferences/workshops
- · mentoring
- · writing publications (e.g., subscriptions to magazines)
- · webinars relevant to marine surveying
- · survey work outside of national law; or
- · surveys completed prior to the MARS system.
