- · names that are the same as or similar to names of registered ships or of ships about to be registered,
- · blasphemous or otherwise offensive names,
- · names of members of the Royal family,
- names that falsely suggest a connection with the Royal family, or international, national, state or local government bodies,
- · names that include prefixes capable of indicating a type of ship (e.g. MV, FV, SS).

- 2. The instrument (if any) by which ownership of the ship passed to the owner named in the application;
- 3. The tonnage certificate (if any) that is in force in relation to the ship;
- 4. If the ship has at any time been registered under the law of a foreign country, documentary evidence that the ship is no longer registered under the law of that country.
