The collection of personal information requested in this form is either required by, authorised by, or to facilitate a process under the *Shipping Registration Act 1981* (the Act) and will be handled in accordance with the *Privacy Act 1988*. Your personal information will be used for purposes related to the Act (including possible overseas disclosure) and will be available for public search in circumstances as the Act requires. Your personal information may be made available to government agencies for statistical and administrative purposes.
