

APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY PASS

Shipping Registration Act 1981

1. Tonnages

Gross and net/register tonnages are measurements of volume. Other types of tonnage such as deadweight or displacement are not applicable.

2. Charterer

The particulars of the charterer are required only if the applicant is a charterer.

3. Proposed commencing and concluding dates

The temporary pass will be valid only during the time span of these dates. Care should be taken to make a realistic estimate of the duration of the voyage.

4. Signature

Where the person signing is a corporation, the declaration may be formally executed under seal. Alternatively an officer of the corporation may sign the form and endorse it with a legible statement of their name and designation and have the signature witnessed.
