

# **APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION**

### **International Register**

Shipping Registration Act 1981 Section 15C, Regulation 7

#### NOTES

Only Australian owned ships are permitted to register under the Australian International Shipping Register. To do so shipowners must comply with the conditions of registration, primarily requiring that the vessel be engaged in international trading for at least fi fty per cent of its annual operations Australian owned. Ships that are unable to comply with these conditions must register on the Australian General Shipping Register.

#### 1. IMO Number

The seven digit number assigned by HIS on behalf of IMO to commercial or trading ships.

#### 2. Hull Identification Number (HIN)

The identifier permanently marked on the hull of a pleasure craft by the manufacturer, or marked later in compliance with State laws (such as the New South Wales Government's Boat Code legislation).

#### 3. Call sign of ship's main radio station

A copy of the ship's call sign licence should be submitted with the application. Please note: call signs are issued by the Australian Communications and Media Authority (ACMA).

#### 4. Proposed ship's name

Names that may not be approved are:

- names that are the same as or similar to names of registered ships or of ships about to be registered,
- blasphemous or otherwise offensive names,
- names of members of the Royal family,
- names that falsely suggest a connection with the Royal family, or international, national, state or local government bodies,
- names that include prefixes capable of indicating a type of ship (e.g. MV, FV, SS).

#### 5. Proposed home port

The presently approved home ports are:

- NSW: Sydney, Newcastle, Port Kembla, Yamba, Jervis Bay, Lake Macquarie, Port Stephens.
- VIC: Melbourne, Geelong, Portland.
- QLD: Abell Point, Brisbane, Bundaberg, Cairns, Gladstone, Hamilton Is., Hayman Is., Karumba, Mackay, Maryborough, Mooloolaba, Mourilyan, Port Douglas, Rockhampton, Rosslyn Bay, Southport, Townsville.

- SA: Port Adelaide, Kingston, Goolwa, Wallaroo, Port Lincoln
- WA: Broome, Fremantle, Dampier, Port Hedland.
- TAS: Hobart, Burnie, Devonport, Launceston.
- NT: Darwin, Gove Harbour.

Other home ports may be declared by the Australian Maritime Safety Authority upon application.

#### 6. Australian national

An Australian national is a person who is an Australian by birth or naturalisation, a company incorporated under Australian Company Law, a Government Authority.
