## HIGHLY VISIBLE COLOURS

## Application

This equivalent solution applies to safety equipment required by NSCV Section C7A to be a highly visible colour.

## **Current Requirement**

NSCV Section C7A, subsection 1.5 (Definitions) states:

highly visible colour— any one of the following colours, as defined in AS 2700:

a) X 15 — Orange.

b) R 11 — International Orange.

c) R 12 — Scarlet.

## Equivalence

Use of the following colours are an approved equivalent means of complying with the highly visible colour requirement stated in NSCV section C7A :

- traffic yellow (British Standard 381C:1996, Ref 368);
- international orange (British Standard 381C:1996, Ref 592);
- golden yellow (AS2700, Ref Y14); or
- A colour of equivalent conspicuity recognised in an Australian standard, ISO standard, IMO standard or UK Merchant Shipping Notice for the purposes of use in marine safety equipment.
