Marine Safety (Expired perpetual certificates) Exemption 2020

I, Michael Kinley, Chief Executive Officer of the Australian Maritime Safety Authority (the National Marine Safety Regulator under section 9 of the *Marine Safety (Domestic Commercial Vessel) National Law*), make this instrument under subsection 143(1) of the *Marine Safety (Domestic Commercial Vessel) National Law*.

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is *Marine Safety (Expired perpetual certificates) Exemption 2020.*

2 Duration

This instrument commences on 1 July 2020 and ceases to have effect at the end of 30 June 2025.

3 Definitions

In this instrument:

Marine Order 505 means Marine Order 505 (Certificates of competency — national law) 2013.

national law means the Marine Safety (Domestic Commercial Vessel) National Law — see Schedule 1 to the Marine Safety (Domestic Commercial Vessel) National Law Act 2012.

National Regulator means the Australian Maritime Safety Authority — see section 9 of the national law.

NSCV — see section 6 of the national law, meaning of **National Standard for Commercial Vessels**.

NSCV Part D means Part D — Crew Competencies of the NSCV.

4 Application

- (1) This instrument applies to a person:
 - (a) who held a certificate of competency (however described) that:
 - (i) was issued under a law of New South Wales; and
 - (ii) expired because of clause 5 of Schedule 8 of the *Marine Safety* (Commercial Vessels) Regulation 2010 (NSW); and
 - (iii) was previously a perpetual certificate; and
 - (b) who has applied for a certificate of competency that is an equivalent qualification, in accordance with Schedule 3 of Part D of the NSCV, to the certificate mentioned in paragraph (a).

5 Exemption

The person is exempt from the requirement to meet the following criteria for the issue of a certificate of competency:

- (a) evidence of completion of a course, mentioned in paragraph (a) of the item in Schedule 1 to Part D of the NSCV, that relates to the certificate;
- (b) for a certificate of competency mentioned in Subdivision 5.2 of Marine Order 505 — qualifying sea service requirements;
- (c) for a certificate of competency mentioned in Subdivision 5.3 of Marine Order 505 — qualifying sea service requirements, if the person meets the requirements mentioned in sections 29 and 30 of Marine Order 505 that would apply if the person were renewing a certificate of competency under that Subdivision.
